I. Background Information:

Purpose: The purpose of this scholarship is to support nurses in the advancement of evidence-based practice and research.

General application information:

- 1) All applications must be submitted electronically and are available from the Seattle Nursing Research Consortium (SNRC) website @ <http://seattlenursingresearch.org> (Conference Scholarship page)
- 2) The deadline for applications is **Tuesday, October 24, 2017**. Applications received after that date will not be considered.
- 3) Applicants who do not comply with guidelines will not be considered.
- 4) Additionally, no other source of funding is available to the applicant (e.g., the hospital/institution already financially supports nurses attending the conference).
- 5) The application covers the SNRC Conference, Workshop or both.
- 6) Awardees, will need to send a short summary (50 words each) after attendance at the Conference, Workshop or both on the following:
 - a) After attending the conference and/or workshop what knowledge/learnings do you plan on using in your clinical practice?
 - b) After attending the conference and/or workshop what knowledge/learnings do you plan on sharing with your colleagues at work and how will you share them (e.g., shared Leadership meetings, staff meetings, unit education poster)?

The short summary, as outlined above, is due by **Tuesday, March 27th, 2018**

Selection Criteria:

- 1) Active RN license number, or nursing program faculty name.
- 2) Actively involved in health care in the role of clinician, educator, or manager
- 3) Completion of application, including demographic information (address, employer, etc.) and typed response to questions.
- 4) Signature of applicant's manager/supervisor.
This is to help ensure the supervisor is also supporting the nurse attending the workshop and/or conference and the associated evidence-based practice/research endeavors.

Essay Questions:

Note: 500 words or less TOTAL for responses to all 4 questions.

Count of 500 words (Does not include the word count for the 4 questions).

- 1) Describe your role as a nurse or nursing student.
Tell us about your current job or position.
- 2) How will attending this research conference and/or workshop impact your practice?
- 3) How do you plan to share what you have learned as a result of attending the SNRC Conference and/or Workshop?
- 4) Tell us about a patient care situation or an evidence based experience which you are proud of your involvement.

Restrictions:

- 1) Monies awarded can only be used to attend the **Seattle Nursing Research Workshop** and the **Seattle Nursing Research Conference**.
- 2) Air travel, and lodging is not included in the scholarship award.
- 3) Recipient must submit CE certificate as proof of attendance.
- 4) Applicants must not be current *Seattle Nursing Research Consortium Board* members but they may be *Seattle Nursing Research Conference and Workshop Planning Committee* members.
